### **AMENDED DECISION**

Sportsman Pub, Inc. dba Old Timers Tavern (“the licensee”) holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (“the Commission”) held a hearing on August 3, 2010 regarding an alleged violation of Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Brad Doyle’s Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee’s Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Brad Doyle.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

#### Facts

1. On, June 2, 2010 at approximately 5:50 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Sportsman Pub, Inc. dba Old Timers Tavern.
2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a bottle of Bud Light for \$3.00. The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. The licensee failed to show up for their scheduled hearing.
4. Administrative review of the file shows that licensee has not had previous violation since 2002.

#### Conclusion

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34 **and therefore suspends the license for four (4) days.**
