## **DECISION**

Vinay Corporation dba Ed's Mini Mart (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on September 21, 2010 regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Brad Doyle's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Brad Doyle.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

### Facts

1. On, June 2, 2010 at approximately 6:50 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation of Vinay Corporation dba Ed's Mini Mart.
2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a 24oz of Bud Light for \$2.39. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

### Conclusion

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c.138, §34. The Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
