








## **Ongoing Green Line Tree Hazards**





- Waterproofing underway on the viaduct










#### **GLX Systems Installation**



- More than 800 Overhead Contact System (OCS) Poles to be place
- Once track is in final position each OCS pole arm is custom fabricated based on distance to the track and rail elevation
- 1" tolerance for up/down/right/left
- Pantographs in Boston are small compared to other systems and account for the number of poles & precision of placement










#### **GLX Systems Installation** con't



- Factory Acceptance Testing (FAT) is complete on signal houses 9 total
- First signal house to be delivered Dec. 1
- One signal house delivery per week to follow

#### **Station Construction - Union Square Station**



- Station platform is taking shape with steel canopy and roof panel installation
- Track placement well underway
- Mechanical building interior work continues











#### **Station Construction – Lechmere Station**



- Station construction & viaduct work extremely active
- Steel canopy installation on platform to start later this month
- Steel elevator tower on north headhouse in place. South elevator tower to go in later this month







#### **Station Construction – East Somerville Station**



- Station construction is advancing
- Steel canopy support post installation expected in November








#### **Station Construction – Gilman Square Station**



- Platform foundation and utility installation work continues
- Additional grading underway on both sides of the platform
- Expect steel for the elevator by late November








#### **Station Construction – Magoun Square Station**



- Station platform foundation in place
- Working to get deck framed up for future pour








#### **Station Construction – Ball Square Station**



- Platform foundation in place as work moves to prepping for deck
- Utility installation very active
- Large waterline tie in completed across tracks to Newbern Ave.








#### **Station Construction – Medford/Tufts Station**



- Station work is advancing
- Preparing for upcoming foundation pour







#### **Washington St. Construction**



- Significant amount of work at track level
- At street level finalizing north sidewalk and plan to have open this month
- Work remains on south sidewalk







## **Medford St. Bridge Construction**



- Rebar installation and reinforcement work continues on the center pier
- Work on retaining wall and abutment is advancing
- Targeting mid-December for bridge deck steel placement









#### **School St. Bridge Construction**



- Steel recently placed to support utilities crossing new span
- Footings being built for the new center pier
- Tie backs in place on new abutment as it is built up and readied for steel










## **Lowell St. Bridge Construction**



- Work on the abutment continues
- No traffic impacts at street level







## **Broadway Bridge Construction**



- Several punch list items remaining
- Roadway and sidewalks fully open

- Preparing exterior for painting

- Focus on making the building weather tight
- Prepping exterior of building for painting
- Interior rough in work continues







# Traction Power Substation Construction – Ball Squai

- Interior work progressing
- Transformers will be placed in early November
- Exterior painting underway







## **Vehicle Maintenance Facility**



• Exterior painting is complete and siding is going up on Vehicle Maintenance Facility. Working to make building weather tight before winter hits











## **Vehicle Maintenance Facility** con't



- Transportation Building interior work is advancing
- Incredible amount of duct bank and utilities continue to be placed
- Asphalt paving has started around perimeter of complex
- Track placement to begin this month









#### Retaining Walls – CA-2A & 2B



- Wall between Cross & McGrath Hwy Bridge
- Excavation of the wall face underway
- We are actively hauling out dirt and closed down Chester Ave site access point
- Shotcrete wall with concrete retaining wall panel placement to follow












## Retaining Walls – MCW-2 con't









#### **Retaining Walls – MCW-2**



- Wall between McGrath Hwy and Walnut St
- Hillside along Medford St. stripped, graded with erosion control matting installed
- Soil nails being place along shotcrete wall similar to wall by Tufts University









## Retaining Walls – MW-7 & 7.5



- Wall between Central and Lowell St
- Excavation complete behind soldier piles
- Concrete retaining wall panel installation next step









#### Retaining Walls – MW-8 & 8.1



- Wall between Cedar & Broadway Bridge
- Pulling soil away from retaining wall foundations and hauling soil used as platform out of area
- Shotcrete hillside between micro piles & place lagging









#### **Community Path**



- Last pieces of steel for viaduct portion of Community Path set last week
- Decking work expected to begin either this year or spring
- Path deck pour across Washington St. set for this week









## **Outreach – Hotline Responses**
