G.P. v. S.P.

Whether the plaintiff was subjected to abuse, specifically, "coercive control" as defined in G. L. c. 209A, § 1 (d), where the defendant publicly posted numerous videos on social media that were critical of the plaintiff.

Whether the "coercive control" provision is vague and overbroad in violation of the First and Fifth Amendments to the United States Constitution and cognate provisions of the Massachusetts Constitution.
