**DECISION**

**QUATRO AMIGOS INC. D/B/A CANCUN'S MEXICAN RESTAURANT**  
**75 WORCESTER ST.**  
**GRAFTON, MA 01536**

Quatro Amigos Inc. d/b/a Cancun's Mexican Restaurant (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 14, 2018, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Keefe's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Keefe's Compliance Check Field Report; and
2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

**FACTS**


1. On Wednesday, May 30, 2018, at approximately 4:50 p.m., Investigators Kujawski and Keefe ("Investigators") investigated the business of Quatro Amigos Inc. d/b/a Cancun's Mexican Restaurant.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a Mike's Hard Lemonade malt beverage, for four dollars cents and twenty-five cents (\$4.25). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the Licensee has been in business for over 12 years with no prior violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
