Granby Liquor Store, Inc. (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. As the licensee has had no previous violations, the Commission issues a WARNING.
