**DECISION**

**GRANBY LIQUOR STORE, INC.**

Granby Liquor Store, Inc. (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, July 24, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2), to wit: c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Carey's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Carey's Compliance Check Field Report dated April 30, 2012; and
  2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

1. On Monday, April 30, 2012 at approximately 06:05 p.m., Investigators Teehan and Carey conducted an investigation of the business operation of Granby Liquor Store, Inc.
2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a six (6) pack of Budweiser beer for seven dollars and thirty cents (\$7.30). The underage operative was not asked for identification.


CONCLUSION


