### **Kidleidoscope**

Join the Park Interpreter at the Interpretive Center for this program focusing on farming. Geared to pre-school age children. Enjoy a story, craft and/or outdoor activity. Please dress in appropriate outdoor wear, close-toed shoes. Parents must accompany children. Meets at the Interpretive Center.

### Off the Beaten Path

Join the Park Interpreter for a slow-paced walk through the park. Each week we hike to a different part of the forest. Water, snack, insect repellent, sunscreen, and binoculars recommended. Children under 15 must be accompanied by an adult. Please dress in appropriate outdoor wear, close-toed shoes. Heavy rain, thunderstorms, or extreme heat will cancel this hike. **Meets at Interpretive Center.**
