Winter Trails Guidelines

As you will see on the map (reverse side), there are designated trails for hiking and for skiing at Great Brook Farm State Park. There is a large parking lot at 1018 Lowell Street which will accommodate both skiers and hikers.

SKIERS: All skiers must have a valid trail pass to use the groomed ski trails. Ski passes are available for purchase at the **Ski Touring Center**, **1018 Lowell Street**, **Carlisle**, **MA**. For more information, the Ski Touring Center can be reached by calling (978)-369-7486 or online at **www.greatbrookski.com**. Please stay on the designated and groomed ski trails.

HIKERS: The Ski Touring Center parking lot gives you easy access to Winter Hiking trails on the West side of Lowell St. (see map). Acorn Trail is an 'easy' trail for your winter hiking enjoyment and Fern Loop trail is moderately challenging. Dogs are allowed on these trails. Park Staff encourages use of these trails for winter uses such as hiking, snowshoeing and dog-walking.

Winter hiking trails in the Indian Hill area are difficult. Please do not walk or cross the groomed ski trails except where marked. No dogs are allowed in this area.

- A snack bar and warming area are available at the Ski Touring Center.
- Abide by and follow all posted signs.
- Dogs are allowed on Acorn & Fern Loop trails <u>ONLY</u>.
- Groomed ski trails are for skiers only.
- Ski Trail Passes and Ski Rentals are available for purchase only at the Ski Touring Center.
- When conditions do not permit groomed skiing, all trails are open for all uses. Call the Ski Touring Center to check on trail conditions.
