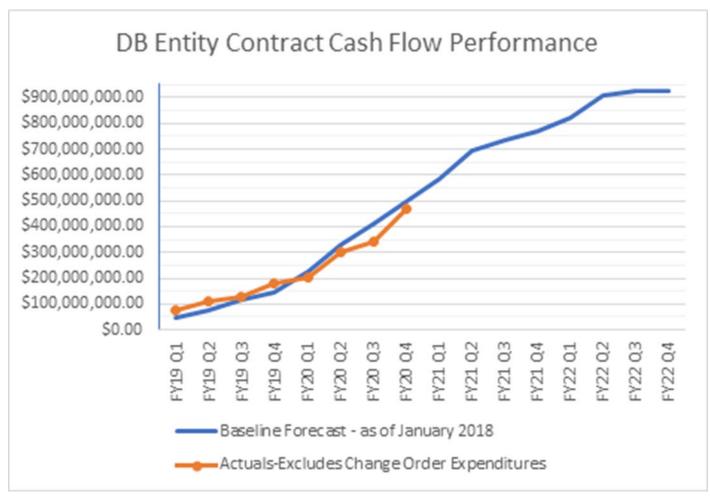

Actuals = Paid only (does not include retainage or change orders)

GLX Change Management

1. Contaminated Soils Transportation and Disposal allowance increase

• Value: \$6.6M*

Impact to revenue service date: None

2. Multi-part Settlement

- Closes 53 existing change items raised by Design-Build Entity
- Closes 3 key disputes previously in Dispute Resolution process
- Value: \$13.5M*
- Impact to revenue service date: None



^{*}Change orders funded from allocated Project Contingency (\$81M remains in contingency budget of original \$127.5M)

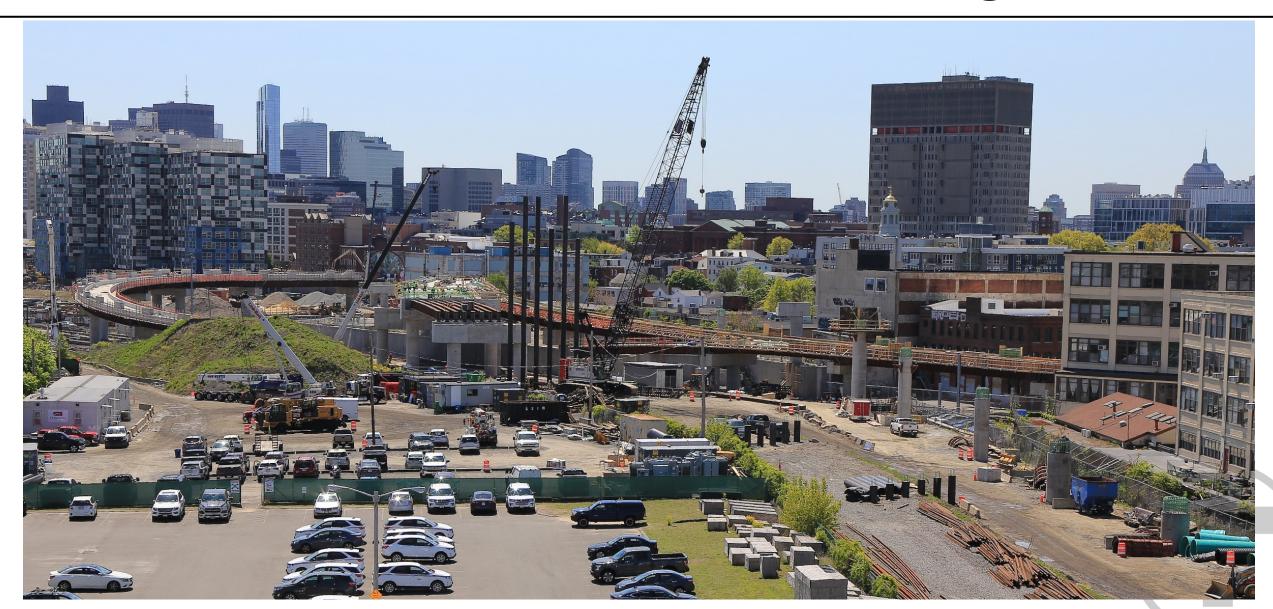

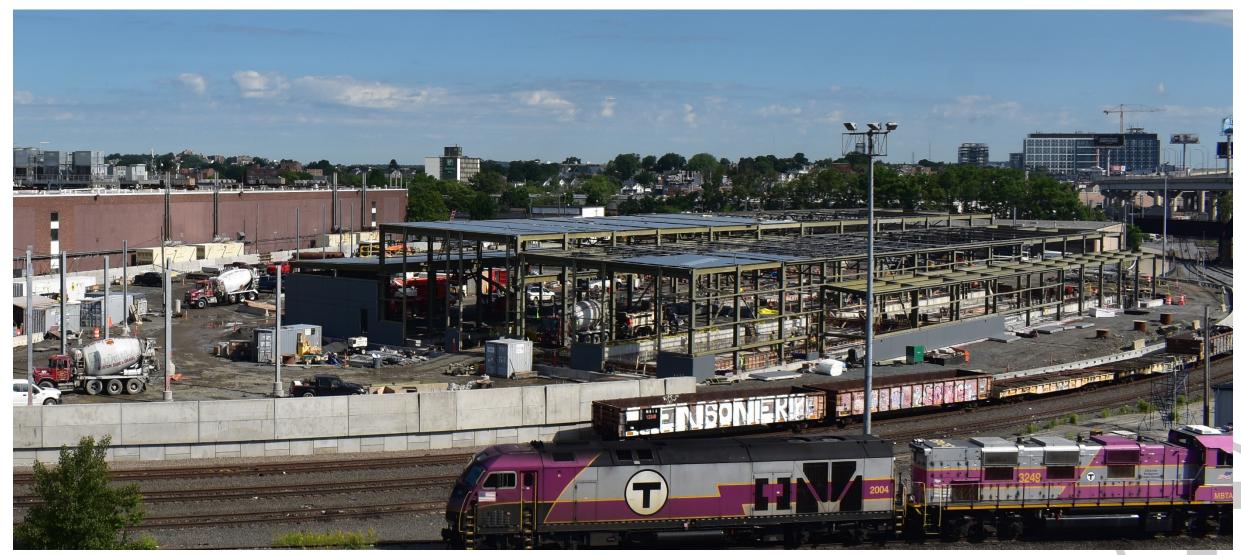

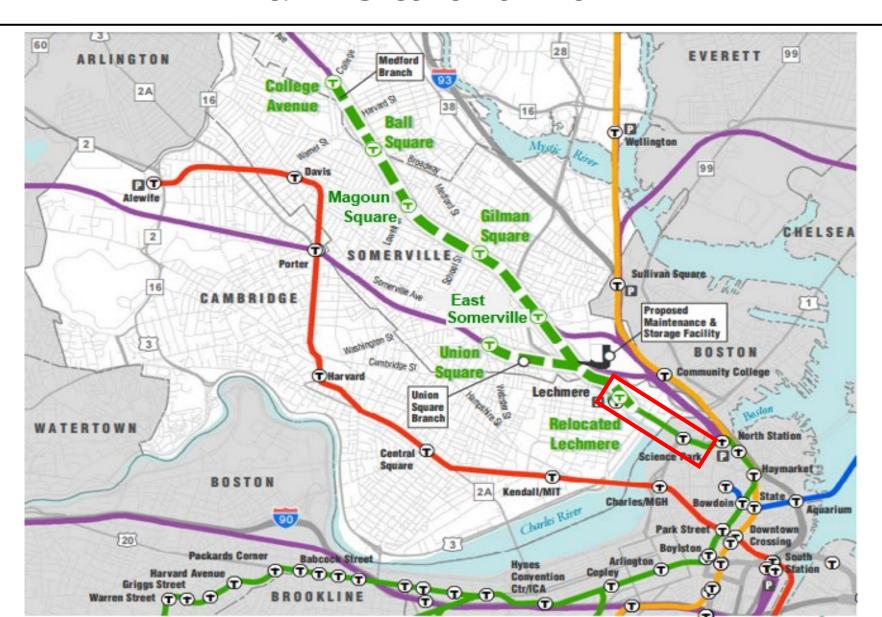

Lechmere Bus Replacement Service

Lechmere Station Operations

- Lechmere viaduct and station removed from service on May 24, 2020 until Summer 2021
- Replacement shuttle buses operating all day via two-way bus lanes
- Bus shuttle performance 10 low floor buses at peak, at 8 minute average headways
- Current ridership is light, slightly over 1,000 passengers a day
- Bus Routes 69, 80, 87, and 88 continue to connect Somerville, Cambridge, Arlington, and Medford to Lechmere

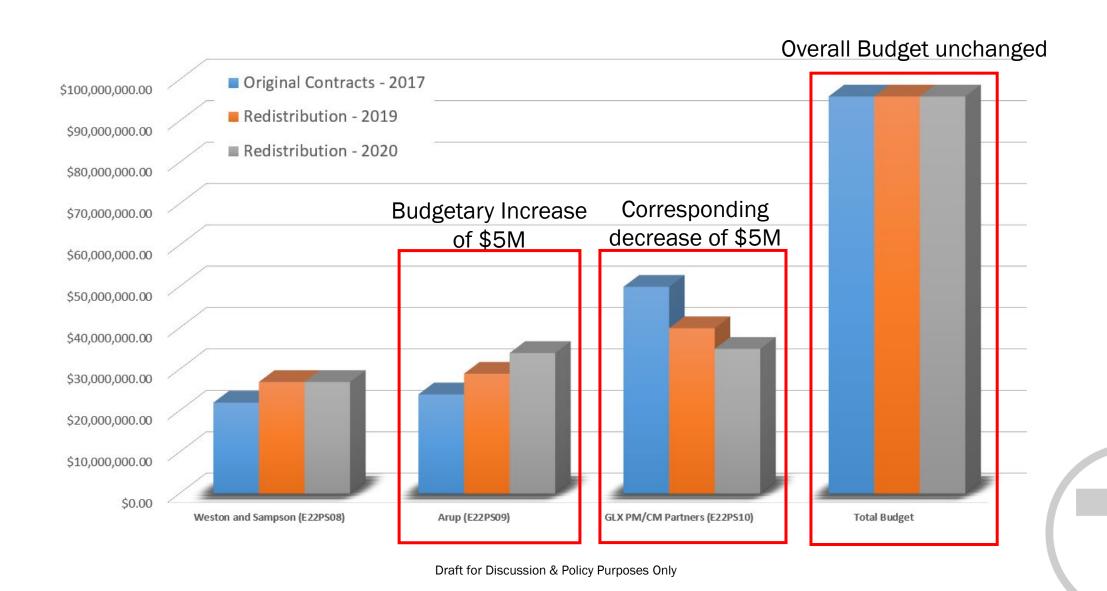


Professional Service Budget Reallocation

- Three professional service contracts are presently supporting GLX implementation.
- Overall budget for professional service contracts (\$96M) remains unchanged since 2016 budget however funding reallocation among contracts is periodically required.
- Board approval required for increase of one professional service contract (corresponding adjustments in other contracts to maintain overall budget value)
