DECISION

Petitioner Becky Griffin appeals from a decision of an Administrative Magistrate of the Division of Administrative Law Appeals (DALA) dismissing her appeal as moot of the decision of respondent State Board of Retirement (SBR) requesting a new medical panel evaluation. The DALA decision is dated October 8, 2021.¹ Ms. Griffin filed a timely appeal to us.

After considering the evidence in the record and the arguments presented by the parties, we incorporate the DALA decision by reference. For the reasons explained in the Decision, we affirm. Ms. Griffin's claim regarding the failure of SBR to process her application for accidental disability retirement was adjudicated separately. Therefore, this appeal is dismissed for mootness.
