The proposed material change involves the affiliation of Hallmark Health Corporation ("Hallmark Health") with Wellforce Inc. ("Wellforce"), pursuant to which Wellforce will become the sole corporate member of Hallmark Health. Wellforce will then serve as the "ultimate parent" entity for the Hallmark Health, Circle Health and Tufts MC systems. The material change will allow a close and effective coordination among the three Wellforce constituents, based on the principle of equal participants in the combined system, to enhance the quality and lower the overall cost of the care they provide to their communities through:

- Operational efficiencies;
- Population health initiatives;
- Effective integration of care across a broad continuum of services from primary to quaternary care throughout a wide geographic area;
- Building on the efforts already undertaken between Circle Health and Tufts MC under Wellforce, fostering closer clinical collaborations between academic and community providers, furthering the redirection of care to more efficient settings, including tertiary and quaternary care, and the retention of more complex cases in the community; and
- Promoting the academic mission of Tufts MC through enhanced and expanded clinical training opportunities in both academic and community environments.

Each of the constituents will retain significant autonomy subject to the reserve powers that will be vested in Wellforce. No consideration is being paid for the transaction. However, Wellforce does contemplate undertaking a financing that would allow investment in capital projects for Hallmark Health. Wellforce is committed to keeping the current health care services provided by Hallmark Health in the local communities, and, through clinical collaborations and investment in capital projects, anticipates supporting and further enhancing those services, including behavioral health services.

15. *Briefly* describe the anticipated impact of the proposed Material Change, including but not limited to any anticipated impact on reimbursement rates, care referral patterns, access to needed services, and/or quality of care:

Hallmark Health's affiliation with Wellforce will further strengthen the goals initially set out by Wellforce (described below) and shared by Hallmark Health, and stabilize and strengthen Hallmark Health following a period of uncertainty as to its future direction. By increasing Wellforce's scale, the affiliation will further Wellforce's efforts to:

- Enhance the delivery of patient-centered care;
- Improve access to high quality, clinically-integrated healthcare services for patients throughout a broad geographic community;
- Implement a common, coordinated approach across the constituent systems to population health management;
- Promote innovation in care management models, disseminate best practices, shared infrastructure and information systems;
- Facilitate care delivery planning to ensure that services are provided in the most efficient setting, with incentives for close collaboration among physicians, facilities and other health care providers; and
- Foster effective clinical integration across the continuum of care, including the implementation of risk-sharing strategies and the achievement of high performance outcomes.

Through Wellforce, the constituent systems will continue implementing a common set of responsibilities that maintains their respective autonomy while proactively promoting a collaborative and comprehensive future-looking strategic vision that reshapes how health care is provided.

In addition, Hallmark Health PHO, Inc. ("HHPHO"), including the Hallmark Health hospital, will begin undertaking payer contracting through an affiliation with the New England Quality Care Alliance, Inc. ("NEQCA"), an affiliate of Tufts MC (which is described in more detail in Notices of Material Changes those parties are filing). The HHPHO/NEQCA affiliation is expected to have a positive effect on total medical expenditures associated with Hallmark Health. To the extent that Hallmark Health does not provide certain tertiary services locally, it is expected that patients of Hallmark Health PHO physicians are likely to receive those services at Tufts Medical Center, a low cost/high quality academic medical center, and that they are likely to receive quaternary services there as well.
