DECISION

R.G.D. Inc. dba Hampden House Cafe (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 12, 2014, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Keefe's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
- 2. Investigator Keefe's Compliance Check Field Report dated February 26, 2014.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

<u>FACTS</u>

- 1. On Wednesday, February 26, 2014, at approximately 5:53 p.m., Investigators Kujawski and Keefe conducted an investigation of the business operation of R.G.D. Inc. dba Hampden House Cafe.
- 2. An underage operative, working with investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Budweiser Light beer for three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
