#### DECISION

# PLAYERS LOUNGE LLC D/B/A THE DRAFT ON 53 645 WASHINGTON STREET HANOVER, MA 02339 LICENSE#: 0492-00052 VIOLATION DATE: 7/10/2019 HEARD: 9/24/2019

Players Lounge LLC d/b/a The Draft On 53 (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("Commission" or "ABCC") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 24, 2019, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34-Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Watson's Report.

- 2. Licensee Stipulation of Fact;
- 3. Copy of Application Approved 3/13/2015.

# **FACTS**

- 1. On Wednesday, July 10, 2019, at approximately 6:18 p.m., Investigators Temple and Watson ("Investigators") investigated the business of Players Lounge LLC d/b/a The Draft On 53.
- 2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a 16-ounce can of Bud Light beer for three dollars and twenty-five cents (\$3.25). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 12 since 2015 with no prior violations.

#### **CONCLUSION**

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21). The Commission issues a **WARNING**.
