MEMORANDUM AND ORDER ON LICENSEE'S  
REQUEST FOR RECONSIDERATION

Hanson Tavern, Inc. dba J & R's Indian Head Pub (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 23, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (1), 204 CMR 2.05 (2) and 204 CMR 2.05 (2).

By decision dated October 4, 2011, the Commission found the licensee in violation of the charges and suspended the license for a total of fifteen (15) days to be served. In addition, the Commission issued a condition that "the licensee must not possess in or on the licensed premises any automatic amusement device or video poker machines."

By letter dated October 28, 2013, the Licensee requested a hearing to reconsider the terms of the suspension. The Licensee stated that he wished to possess four machines for entertainment purposes only. The machines are: Buck Hunting, Trivia, Pinball, and Jukebox. The Commission held a hearing on Thursday, December 12, 2013, where the Licensee argued that good cause exists to reconsider the terms of the suspension.

Based on the evidence, the Commission reconsiders its prior decision and will allow the Licensee to possess the four requested machines: Buck Hunting, Trivia, Pinball, and Jukebox.
