## OTHER ELECTRIC REVENUE\*

Other Electric Revenue \$2,443,626 Other electric revenue is the return on rate base, or the equity component of the revenue requirement. MWRA will be billed these amounts once approved by the MA DPU.

#### **REGULATORY CREDIT\***

Regulatory Credit \$-715,717 Regulatory credit is the deferred depreciation expense expected to be in new distribution rates once approved by the MA DPU.
