Hans & Hans Inc. dba Hardwick Market & Package Store (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, March 3, 2015, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Velez's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 2. Investigator Velez's Compliance Check Field Report dated January 20, 2015.

## <u>FACTS</u>

- 1. On Tuesday, January 20, 2015, at approximately 5:39 p.m., Investigators Binienda and Velez conducted an investigation of the business operation of Hans & Hans Inc. dba Hardwick Market & Package Store.
- 2. An underage operative, working with investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, a 6-pack of Budweiser Light beer for seven dollars (\$7.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

## CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
