Prisha Corporation dba Value Mart (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 13, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jamie Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
- 2. Compliance Check Field Report dated April 27, 2011.

A. Policy on Alcohol Server Training.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

FACTS

- 1. On April 27, 2011 at approximately 5:02 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Prisha Corporation dba Value Mart.
- 2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a six (6) pack of Bud Light for six dollars and ninety cents (\$6.90). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. Administrative review of the file indicates this is the first violation for the licensee.

<u>CONCLUSION</u>

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
