DECISION

MAULIK CORP. D/B/A VALUE MART 435 ROUTE 28 HARWICH, MA 02646 LICENSE#: 00083-PK-0506 and 90274-PK-0506 VIOLATION DATE: 6/13/2022 HEARD: 11/01/2022

Maulik Corp. d/b/a Value Mart ("Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("ABCC" or "Commission") held a remote hearing via Microsoft Teams on Tuesday, November 1, 2022, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Velez's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Velez's Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report;
- 2. ABCC Form 43, Transfer of License Approval, 1/14/2014;
- 3. ABCC Licensing Authority Certification, Seasonal License Approved, 5/27/2022;
- 4. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On Monday, June 13, 2022, at approximately 4:11 p.m., Investigators Binienda and Velez ("Investigators"), inspected the business operation of Maulik Corp. d/b/a Value Mart.
- 2. An underage operative, working under the supervision of Investigators, purchased alcoholic beverages, one 6-pack of White Claw hard seltzer, for eleven dollars and forty-nine cents (\$11.49). The underage operative was not asked to produce identification.
- 3. Bahecharbhai Patel, Licensee, appeared at the Commission hearing. The Commission was informed the clerk who made the sale to the underage operative is no longer allowed to process sales, the Licensee is requiring recertification of all employees via TIPS training and has purchased a state-of-the-art scanner.

<u>CONCLUSION</u>

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Therefore, the Commission issues a WARNING.
