- Rule 2. For the purpose of this tariff it shall be understood that whenever the term Shipper is used it shall mean the party who contracts with the Carrier and who is the one responsible for the payment of the Carriers charges.
- Rule 3. In the event it becomes necessary for the Carrier to supply additional labor in excess of the driver such labor shall be supplied at the following charges:

Extra Man \$15.00 per man per hour.

- Rule 4. Any toll, ferry, tunnel or other such charges required to be paid by the Carrier shall be added to the charges set forth in this tariff.
- Rule 5. If in the performance of any transportation service it shall become necessary for the Carrier to procure special license and permits the cost of such license and/or permit shall be borne by the shipper.
- Rule 6. Computation of time on the hourly rate shall be from the time of the vehicle and driver reporting on the job until the completion of the unloading of the last load.
- Rule 7. Waiting or delay time either at the point of loading or at the point of unloading and when through no fault of the Carriers and in excess of thirty (30) minutes shall be charged at the applicable hourly rate and shall be in addition to the Transportation Rate set forth herein:

Rate: By applicable hourly rate is meant the rate applicable to the particular size and type of vehicle used.

Rule 8. All yardage and tonnage rates set forth in this tariff are subject to one pick up and one delivery.

The computation of the mileage charges applicable to the tonnage Rule 1. and yardage rates shall be the accurate mileage from point of loading to point of unloading. Said actual mileage to be agreed upon by both the shipper and the carrier. The actual agreed mileage is to be recorded by the Carrier on his Freight Bills or Records of Transportation Charges as set forth in Rule 17 (D.P.U. 10405). On fractions of miles, no charges shall be added unless the distance exceeds five-tenths (5/10) of a mile in which case the charge will be based on the next mile.
