NOTICE OF SUSPENSION

After a hearing on April 5, 2011, the Commission finds Hans Enterprises, Inc. dba Hans Garden in violation of Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34C and 204 CMR 4.03 (1a).

The Commission **suspends the licensee's license for a total of four (4) days to be served.** The suspension shall commence on **Wednesday, August 17, 2011 and terminate on Saturday, August 20, 2011.** The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Wednesday, August 17, 2011 at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee Sunday, August 21, 2011.

You are advised that pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c.138 §23, you may petition the Commission to accept an offer in compromise in lieu of suspension within twenty (20) calendar days following such notice of such suspension. If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form. All checks must be certified and accompanied by the enclosed form, which must be signed by a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.


