DECISION

Michele L. Sabri dba White Hen Pantry (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c.138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on September 28, 2010 regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Rose Egan-Bailey's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Compliance Check field report of Investigator Rose Egan-Bailey.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

Facts

1. On July 22, 2010, members of the Haverhill Police Department conducted compliance checks in the City of Haverhill.
2. At approximately 8:00 p.m., an underage operative, working with the Haverhill Police Department, purchased a six-pack of Bud Light bottles for \$7.73 from Michele L. Sabri dba White Hen Pantry. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

Conclusion

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. The Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
