

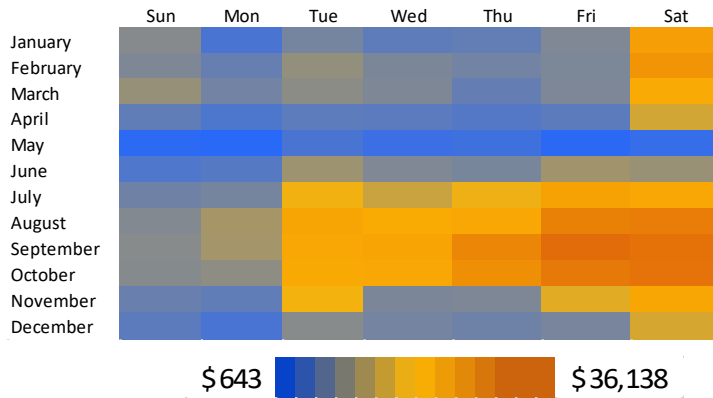

Average Daily HIP Incentives

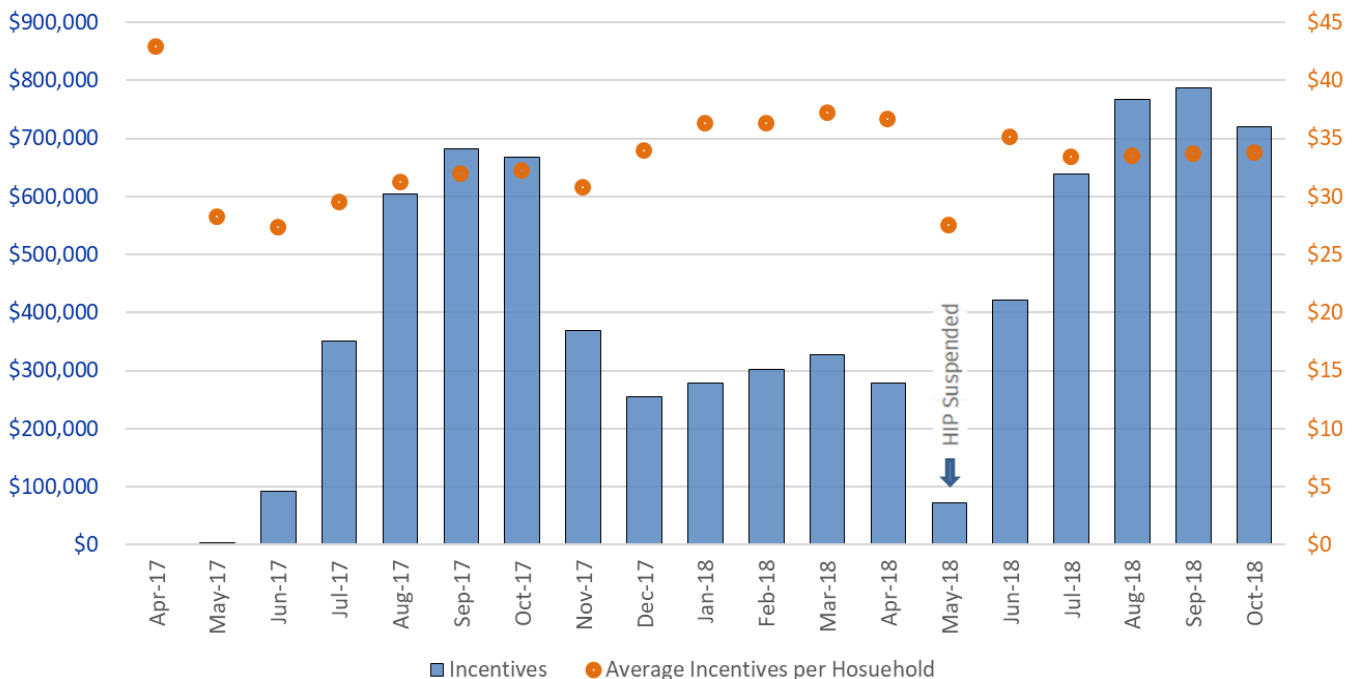


Households with a recipient age 60+ **46%**

HIP clients with a disability **34%**

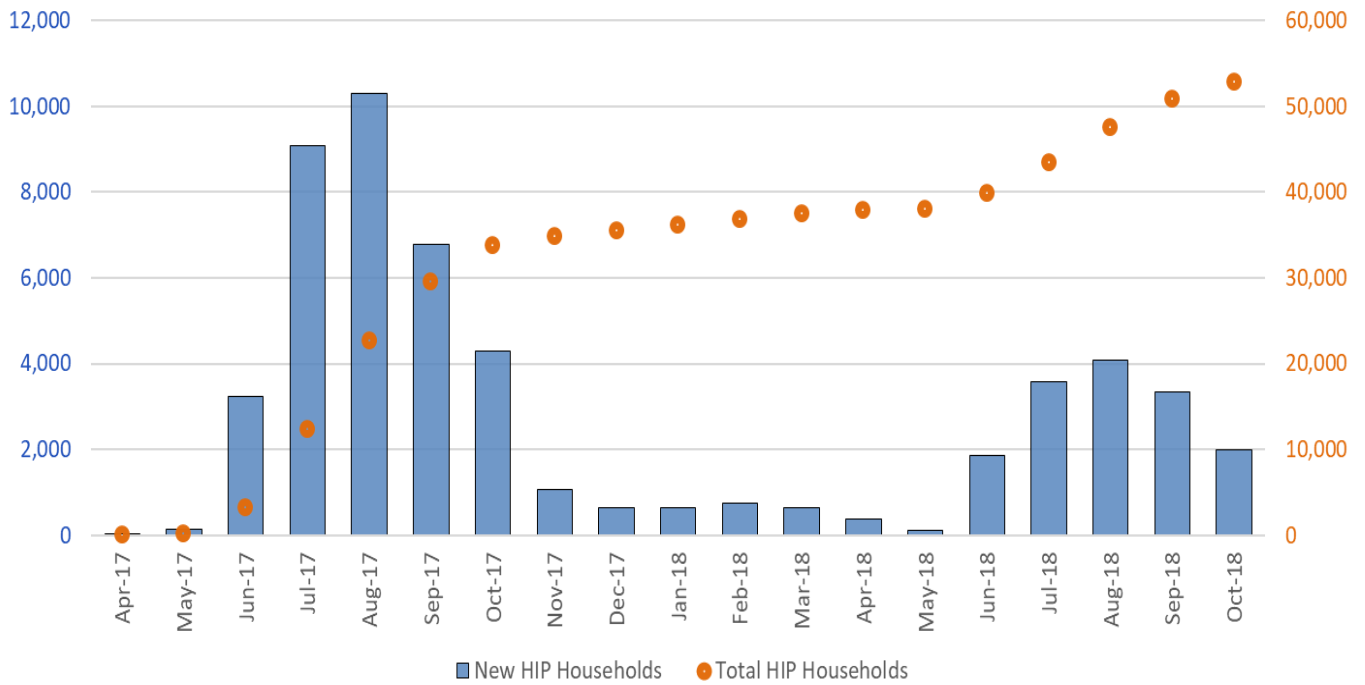
Households with a recipient under age 18 **30%**

HIP Incentives by Month

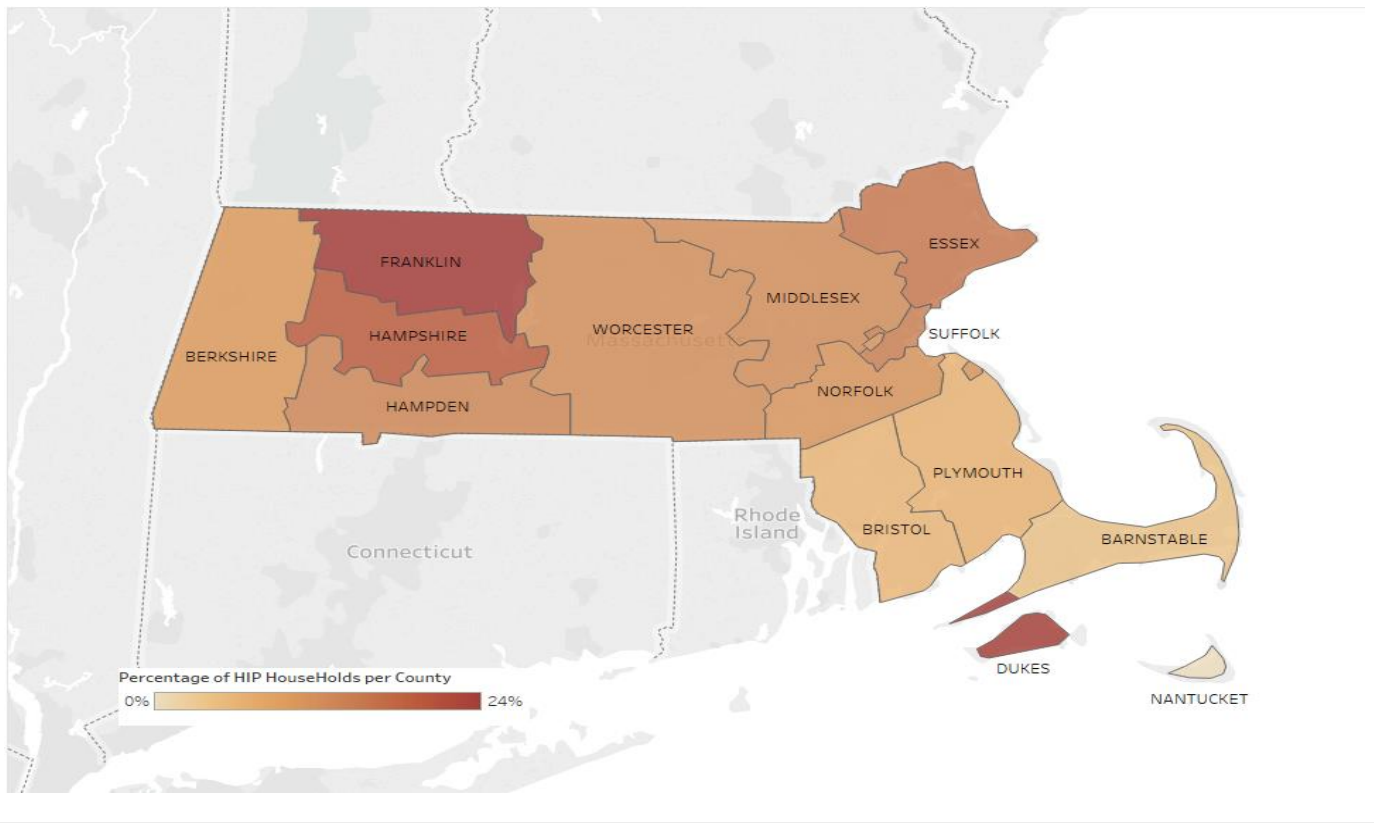




HIP Households by Month

<p>Healthy Incentives Program (HIP)</p>	<p>Eating fruits and vegetables each day is important for your health. HIP helps you buy more fruits and vegetables for your household.</p> <p>We automatically enroll SNAP households in HIP.</p> <p>Use your SNAP benefits at one of our HIP retailers to buy fruits and vegetables. You will receive \$1 for each dollar you spend on eligible fruits and vegetables, up to a monthly limit. <p>Fiscal Year (FY)</p>	<p>Fiscal Year 2019 runs from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019</p>								
<p>Healthy Incentives Program (HIP) Timeline</p>	<p>Apr 4, 2017 – The first HIP incentive is earned Sep 10, 2017 – Incentives exceed initial 3-year projection of \$1.25M Apr 15, 2018 – Incentives uptake equal program funding, requiring suspension May 23, 2018 – Supplemental funding allows the program to restart July 1, 2018 – HIP receives \$4M in state funding for fiscal year 2019</p>
