RE: HEARING AID SERVICES FOR MEMBERS ENROLLED IN MASSHEALTH

MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATIONS

Background

Effective July 1, 1998, the Division entered into new contracts with the following managed care organizations (MCOs).

- Boston Medical Center HealthNet Plan
- Fallon Community Health Plan
- Harvard Pilgrim Health Care
- Kaiser Permanente/Community Health Plan
- Neighborhood Health Plan
- Network Health

Before January 1, 1999, these MCOs were not required to provide the hearing aid benefit to their MassHealth MCO members.

Contract Change

Effective for dates of service on or after January 1, 1999, the MCOs listed above are responsible for providing hearing aid services to their MassHealth members. In accordance with 130 CMR 450.105(A)(3)(a) and (B)(3)(a), the Division will **not** reimburse hearing aid dispensers for these MassHealth members enrolled in the MCOs listed above for hearing aid services provided on or after January 1, 1999.

Authorization and Payment from MCOs

Effective for any date of service on or after January 1, 1999, for members enrolled with a MassHealth MCO, hearing aid dispensers should seek authorization and payment from the member's MCO.

Recipient Eligibility Verification System

In accordance with 130 CMR 450.107(C)(2), providers must check the Recipient Eligibility Verification System (REVS) to verify a member's eligibility and covered benefits to ensure appropriate payment.
