# **Restoring I-93 HOV Southbound**

**MassDOT Restoring I-93 HOV Lane** 





#### **Overview:**

- Restores HOV Lane for Monday, November 23<sup>rd</sup>
- Temporary measure was to alleviate impacts of:
  - Tobin/Chelsea
  - North Washington Street Bridge
  - GLX full bridge closures/detours

### Ongoing mitigation efforts:

- Additional MBTA Blue Line trains
- Free inbound SL service from Chelsea
- CharlieCards accepted on Commuter Rail
  - Between Chelsea and North Station



Southborough-Westborough I-90 Superstructure Replacements (EB & WB) over Woodland, Cordaville, Parkerville and Flanders Roads






Estimated Start Dates and Durations:

- November 2021 Flanders Rd. Utility Relocation
- January 2021 May 2021 I-90 Median Barrier Replacement
- January 2021 July 2021 Bridge Abutment Repairs
- March 2021 April 2021 Median Crossover Construction
- May 2021 Movable Barrier Trial Run
- June 2021 August 2021 Bridge Replacements
- August 2021 October 2021 I-90 Median Barrier Replacement
- July 2021 November 2021 Final Paving

## Snow & Ice 2020 Overview

- Perform snow and ice removal on 15,000+ lane miles.
- 6 Districts and 20 sub-Districts.
- 150 Depots/ Salt Storage Locations.
- Over 700 personnel at the height of a storm.








## Snow & Ice 2020 Response to Covid-19

- 1. MassDOT Staff report to assigned depots only.
  - No overlap between defined crews.
  - All staff masked.
  - Facility areas cleaned at appropriate frequency.
- 2. Hired Vendors masked and isolated from MassDOT staff.
  - Depot buildings off-limits to Vendors, excepting emergencies.
  - Portable restroom facilities for Vendors provided and maintained at appropriate frequency.
  - Vendor deployment and management will be phone/radio based.
- 3. Contactless Practices will mitigate contagion risks.
  - Paperless Vendor Agreement submission and bi-weekly invoicing.
  - PPE (gloves, eye protection) not to be shared.



- 1. MassDOT is continuing use of GPS and GIS to analyze activities and performance during and post storms to increase effectiveness and efficiency.
- 2. Expanding and upgrading network of RWISs (Road Weather Information Systems), adding more Fixed and Mobile Grip sensors. Area Supervisors will carry mobile RWISs to inform treatment needs.
- 3. Expanded use of Weather forecasts, alerts and warning emails are available from our contractor to any municipality who would like to receive this information.
- 4. Investigating sidewalk and bike lane contract mechanisms and treatment methods.
