Snow and Ice Prep Update

Winter Forecast



- The first half of winter should contain the warmest anomalies
- There is a chance for some colder periods to develop later this winter
- Below-normal snowfall is anticipated
- The storm track favors systems from the southwest, providing elevated risks for larger coastal storms
- Less than average risk for freezing rain, especially in early winter



Snow and Ice Prep Update

- Vendor signups, vendor inspections, and vendor training sessions are ongoing
- Continuing to see a decline in the number of vendors
- New salt contract is in place for FY24
- Currently at 90% of capacity and should be at 95% by December
- Contracts with our weather forecast provider (DTN) are in place
- Prepping MassDOT snow and ice equipment
- Meeting with partners to ensure good coordination and communication
