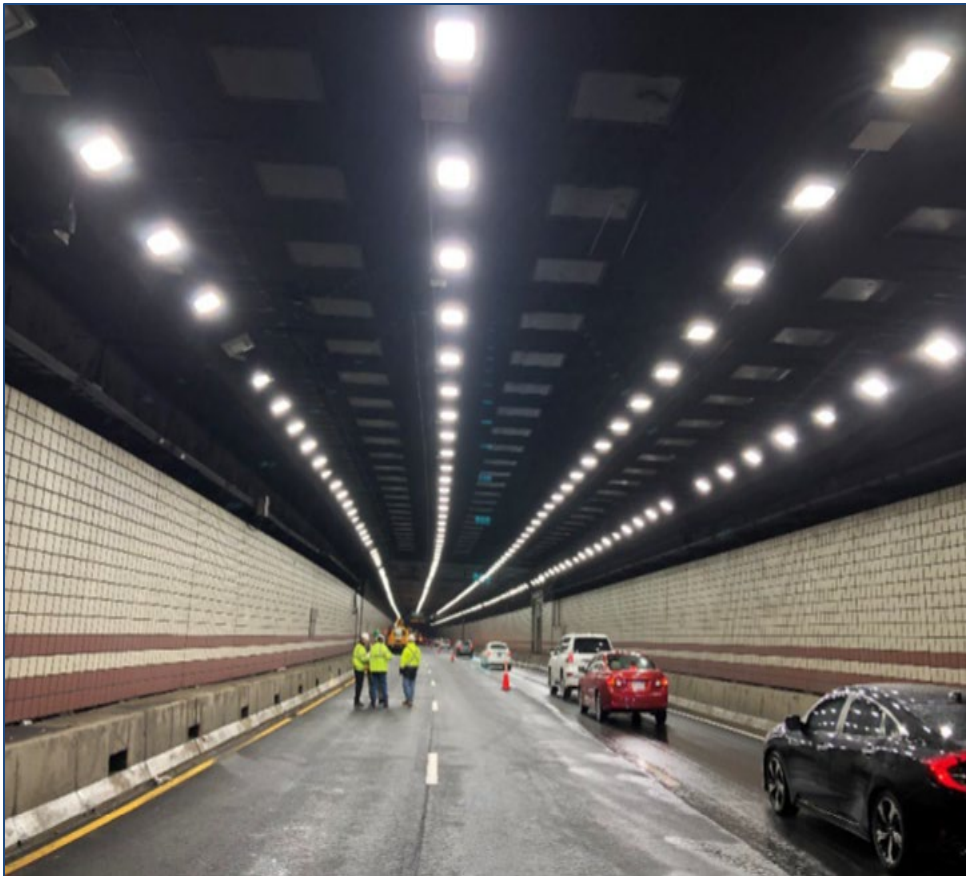

Tunnel Lighting Enhancements



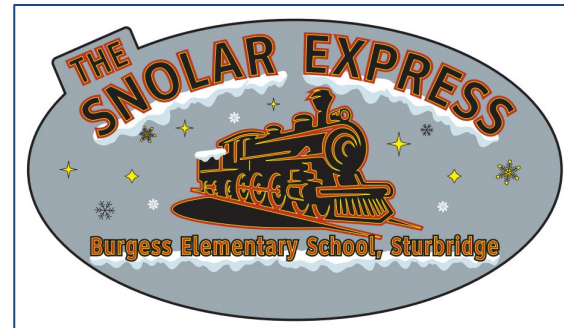
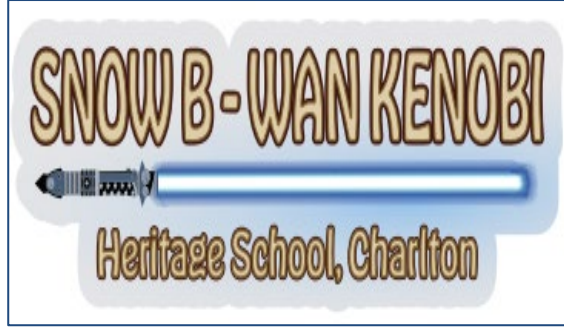
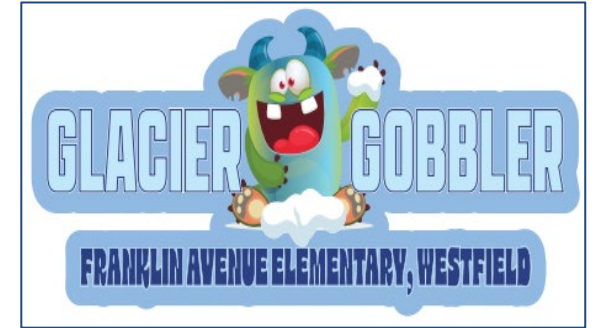
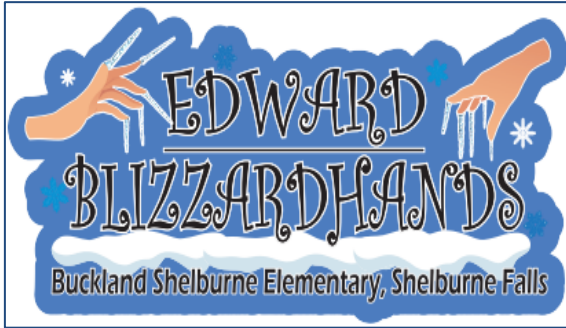
- Beginning in 2019, 6 contracts have been released with projects under construction or already completed with a 7th and final contract going out to bid soon.
- Include the furnishing and installation of new LED tunnel luminaires and upgrades of the function lighting systems. Estimated completion of all planned projects currently set for 2027.
- Total Number of Fixtures 15,719, 6,570 Completed (Nov. 2023)
- Total Eversource rebate so far (completed to date): \$3.26M
 - Central Artery= \$2.77
 - Sumner= \$214,00
 - Ted Williams= \$264,000
- There are still rebates that are coming as some of the work has not progressed far enough to trigger

Chapter 90 Testimony



- On January 30th, testified before the Joint Committee on Transportation in support of H. 4283, An Act Financing Improvements to Municipal Roads and Bridges
- Proposes funding Chapter 90 at \$400M spanning state FY25 and state FY26
- The two-year approach is the result of many conversations with municipalities across the Commonwealth
- The Governor's budget also proposes supplementing Chapter 90 with an additional \$100M and another \$24M for rural and regional transportation

Sumner Tunnel Phase 2

- Initial weekend closure scheduled for March 1st
- Additional closures to be scheduled
- Work is in support for a partial deck replacement this summer
- Initial weekend closures will include removal and replacement of the driving surface to expose areas of the deck for structural repair
- MassDOT is coordinating with stakeholders and will reconvene working groups over the next several months in advance of the planned July-August full closure
- Updates to continue at each board meeting up until completion of project
