




Before Demolition

Tunnel Shutdown Schedule








Coordination with Adjacent Projects

- MassDOT has coordinated work with all major capital programs
- MassDOT has accelerated necessary maintenance activities in the area, including the Ted Williams (I-90) and Tip O'Neill (I-93) tunnels
- Where possible, work is being suspended on nearby projects
- Maintenance activity is being limited to emergency work and schedule for off hours
- Existing traffic confutations for fixed work zones have been incorporated into the management plan
- Command Center structure will be used for initial phase of construction





Managing Impacts

East Boston/North End

- Discounted tolls for the Tobin Bridge and Ted Williams Tunnel (must be in the Resident Discount Program)
- Free MBTA Ferry service from East Boston to Downtown
- Free monthly passes for July and August for residents enrolled in the Resident Discount Program
- Additional parking near Wood Island Station
- Signal phasing and timing changes
- Field Monitoring Units

North Shore

- Zone 1A fares for Salem and Swampscott inbound & outbound
- Additional capacity added to Newburyport/Rockport
 Commuter Line
- Salem, Swampscott, Beverley Depot and Rowley Commuter Rail parking lots reduced to \$2/day
- Discounted parking at all Blue Line lots (\$2 a day)
- Real Time information
- •• Transit passes (Revere and Winthrop)









Logan Airport

- Logan Express 25% discount and kids >12 are free
