Project Location





Overview



- Replacement of Bridge L-18-016=S-05-008 (Bascule)
- Removal of temporary movable bridge
- 3060 feet of Route 107 and Ballard Street will be reconstructed
- Addition of vehicle turning lanes at Ballard Street and Route 107 Intersection
- Replacement of MWRA water line
- Requesting MassDOT Board approval of \$87.5M contract with SPS New England
- Work will take 5 years to complete; staged to maintain 2-lanes of traffic

Purpose and Need




- Temporary bridge with limited service life
- Permanent bridge will provide a reliable crossing with reduced maintenance costs
- Permanent bridge will restore 4-lanes of traffic in normal alignment
- Ballard Street intersection operating at substandard level of service
- Deficient pedestrian accommodation
- Deficient bicycle accommodation

Construction Scope



- Demolish remaining bridge and construct replacement bridge
- Install new MWRA water line
- Add turning lanes to Route 107 and Ballard Street Intersection and associated signals



- 2-lanes of traffic maintained throughout construction
- Removal of temporary bridge
- Install new independent fender system
- Increase the navigation channel width

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Traffic Impacts



- 2-lanes of traffic will be maintained at all times
- Staged construction required to perform bridge approach and intersection work
- MBTA bus stop to remain in operation
- Navigation traffic to be maintained except for negotiated shortterm closures

Procurement



- Project was advertised September 14, 2019
- Engineers Estimate was \$84,038,000
- Bid Opening was October 20, 2020
- Five (5) bids were received:
