- Second weekend of lane reductions finished six hours ahead of schedule at 11pm on Sunday, June 22nd
- Across both weekend closures:
- Removed 332 cubic yards of concrete
- Installed 205 cubic yards of rapid set concrete
- Installed 31 precast bridge unites
- 85 workers on site around the clock
- Second weekend experienced ~30 percent reduction in traffic volumes











Daily Volume Reduction, Weekend 1



HEKA – Highway Engineer Knowledge Assistant




- Developed in 2024
- One of the first AI tools developed for under the Governor's AI for Impact program
- Developed in collaboration between Northeastern University and MassDOT
- The AI is trained on a myriad of MassDOT SOP's, Engineering Directives, and permit documents to help staff through daily issues at MassDOT
- Has produced a 78% time savings over manual research



July 10 Flash Flooding

- July 10 was 1-in-200-year event
- 5.5-6.5 inches of rain in under 12 hours after several days of heightened precipitation
- The intense runoff overwhelmed receiving waterways and drainage infrastructure
- Road closures on I-93 in Milton, Quincy, Braintree
- MassDOT maintenance forces were predeployed to alleviate flooding as quickly as possible






Service Plazas Update

- Workstreams are progressing




