# I-90/I-95 Project

## Newton and Weston

3



- I-90 Mainline  
Complete Phase 1 steel erection mid-March
- MBTA Bridge  
Rapid construction weekends scheduled for 5/30 -6/2 and 6/20 -6/23
- Ramps A/B  
Demo bridge over the Charles River mid-late 2025  
Demo/ reconstruct bridge over I-95 to continue through end of 2025
- Ramp G/P (EB on Ramp from I-95)  
Traffic switch to new bridge in early July  
Remaining I-90 EB traffic switch to new bridge in mid-late July  
Demo of existing EB bridge in late July/ early August 2025
- Ramp G  
Construction underway, decks poured by November/ December 2025

# William “Bill” Russell Bridge

## Boston and Charlestown

4



- Formerly North Washington St. Bridge
- FBU (Full Beneficial Use) date for the new bridge is still scheduled for April/ May 2025
- Completion and FBU for Lovejoy Wharf and Tudor Wharf scheduled for May 2025
- Completion of the full project is scheduled for August 2025



# I-495/I-90 Project

## Hopkinton and Westborough

5



- Ramp from I-90 WB to I-495 NB  
Substructure work is ongoing and steel erection work will begin this summer
- I-90 construction  
Work is progressing on the I-90 bridge over MBTA/CSX/Amtrak rail tracks
- Ramp from I-495 south to I-90 east  
Final road construction continues for traffic relocation to the new ramp alignment
- I-495 traffic crossover  
Work is progressing on the substructure for I-495 over the railroad tracks, with steel erection coming next.
- Fruit Street Bridge  
Phase 2 construction is ongoing
- Project is on schedule with FBU of August 2027

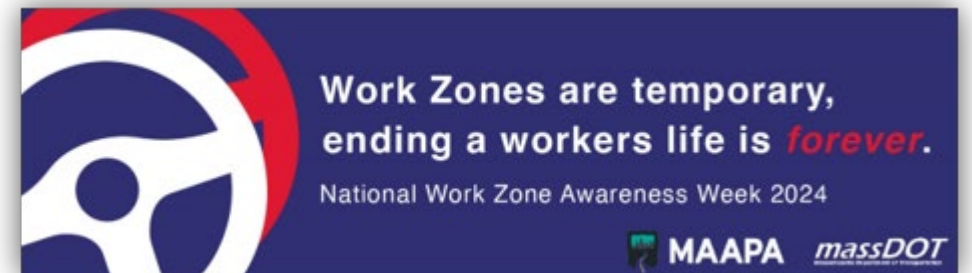


# Annual Work Zone Safety Billboard Design Contest

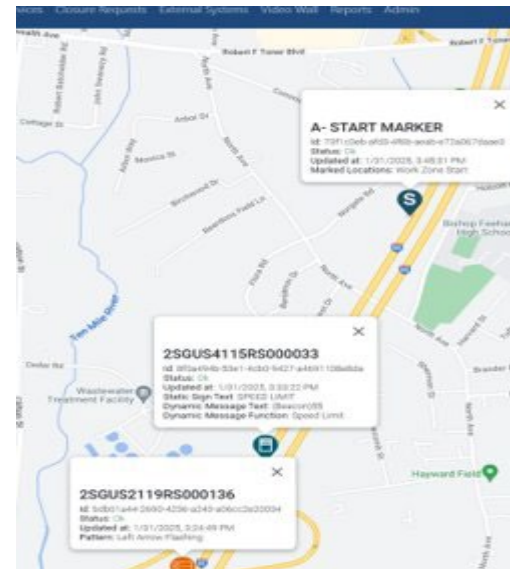


- MassDOT launched the 2025 Work Zone Safety Digital Billboard Design Contest on February 21<sup>st</sup>
