




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

- Warmer than average conditions are expected during this winter season
- There is some risk for colder periods to develop in late winter
- Below normal snowfall is expected
- The storm track system favors the track from the central Rockies through the Great Lakes
- Less than average risk for freezing rain events










- Snow and ice vendor signups, inspections, and training sessions are ongoing
- Continuing to see a decline in the number of vendors; 8% decline overall from last year
- We are currently at 83% salt capacity and should be at 95% by December
- Contracts with our weather forecast provider (DTN) are in place for the FY25 winter season
- MassDOT staff has been prepping snow and ice equipment for the season








FY 24 Construction Spending = \$1.35B


- The largest dollar amount spent in a year
