**DECISION**

**SLESAR BROS. BREWING CO. D/B/A HINGHAM BEER WORKS  
18 SHIPYARD DRIVE (NO. 1K)

Slesar Bros. Brewing Co. d/b/a Hingham Beer Works (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 18, 2018, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Watson's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Watson's Compliance Check Field Report; and
2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

**FACTS**

1. On Tuesday, May 22, 2018, at approximately 7:26 p.m., Investigators Temple and Watson ("Investigators") investigated the business of Slesar Bros. Brewing Co. d/b/a Hingham Beer Works.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a Fenway Pale ale, for six dollars and forty-three cents (\$6.43). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

### CONCLUSION


Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Therefore, the Commission **suspends the license for one (1) day which will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
