DECISION

HOLBROOK BEER & WINE, INC. D/B/A HOLBROOK CENTER PACKAGE STORE 41 PLYMOUTH STREET HOLBROOK, MA 02343 LICENSE#: 88874-PK-0532 VIOLATION DATE: 4/01/2019 HEARD: 7/16/2019

Holbrook Beer & Wine, Inc. d/b/a Holbrook Center Package Store (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("Commission" or "ABCC") held a hearing on Tuesday, July 16, 2019, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Kenny's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Kenny's Compliance Check Field Report;
- 2. Licensee Stipulation of Fact; and
- 3. Licensee's License Application.

FACTS

- 1. On Monday, April 1, 2019, at approximately 6:02 p.m., Investigators Teehan and Kenny ("Investigators") investigated the business of Holbrook Beer & Wine, Inc. d/b/a Holbrook Center Package Store.
- 2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a 6-pack of Bud Light beer, for six dollars and ninety-eight cents (\$6.98). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)-Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21). As the Licensee has had no previous violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
