Re: Permits for Holiday Openings

Thanksgiving Day-November 28, 2024 and Christmas Day-December 25, 2024

The Department of Labor Standards must approve all local permits to allow retail stores and businesses to perform work and to be open on certain holidays, including Thanksgiving, November 28, 2024, and Christmas Day, December 25, 2024. Permits must be approved by the Department of Labor Standards on a uniform basis statewide. See Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 136, §15.

Please be advised that the Department of Labor Standards will <u>NOT</u> issue statewide approval for permits for businesses to open on Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day 2024.
