**DECISION**

**RAJMAN INC. D/B/A STOP & GO  
399 HILLSIDE AVE.

Rajman Inc. d/b/a Stop & Go (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission" or "ABCC") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 24, 2017, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Di Cicco's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Di Cicco's Compliance Check Field Report; and
2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

**FACTS**

1. On Wednesday, July 12, 2017, at approximately 7:03 p.m., Investigators Lordan and Di Cicco ("Investigators") investigated the business operation Rajman Inc. d/b/a Stop & Go.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a 6-pack of Budweiser Light beer for nine dollars and fifty cents (\$9.50). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

### CONCLUSION

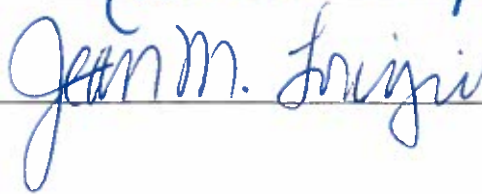
Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Therefore, the Commission **suspends the license for a period of three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
