RE: **Updated COVID-19 Vaccine Guidance for Home Health Agency Providers**

Introduction

MassHealth is issuing this bulletin to update the COVID-19 vaccine guidance for home health agency providers. This bulletin supersedes Home Health Agency Bulletins 69, 72, and 75.

COVID-19 Vaccine Guidance

As of September 12, 2023, MassHealth rescinds the requirements of Home Health Agency Bulletins 69, 72, and 75 regarding COVID-19 vaccinations. Vaccination remains the safest strategy for avoiding hospitalizations, long-term health outcomes, and death. MassHealth strongly encourages agencies to have their direct care workers remain up to date on COVID-19 vaccinations, per the most current applicable Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommendation.

MassHealth home health agencies must develop and implement a policy to provide education to their direct care workers regarding the importance of vaccination, as well as provide resources and assistance to support direct care workers in becoming vaccinated. The CDC serves as a valuable resource to support education on the importance of vaccination and is a recommended source of information.
