Background: The US Department of Labor (DOL), Veterans' Employment and Training

Service (VETS), announced the availability of approximately \$12 million in grant funds authorized under Title 38 of United States Code (U.S.C.), Sections 2021 and 2023. Approximately \$12 million will be awarded in different communities throughout the country with the maximum limit for an individual award of \$500,000. Please note that an applicant operating an HVRP grant during July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017, must plan in its application to provide follow-up services for former program participants using funds made available under this

solicitation.
