### DECISION

HOPEDALE MART, LLC DBA HOPEDALE MART 404 SOUTH MAIN HOPEDALE, MA 01747 LICENSE#: 054200004 HEARD: 07/26/2012

Hopedale Mart, LLC dba Hopedale Mart (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Thursday, July 26, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2), to wit: c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Kujawski's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Kujawski's Compliance Check Field Report dated April 4, 2012; and
- 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

### **FACTS**

- On Monday, April 02, 2012, at approximately 08:29 p.m., Investigators Keefe and Kujawski conducted an investigation of the business operation of Hopedale Mart, LLC dba Hopedale Mart.
- 2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a container of Bud Light beer for two dollars and forty-nine cents (\$2.49). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

## **CONCLUSION**

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
