## To: EOHLC Field Staff From: Chris Thompson, Undersecretary, Division of Housing Stabilization (Feb 5, 2024 2008 EST) Date: February 5, 2024 RE: Housing Stabilization Notice 2024-01, Implementation of Increase in the Federal Poverty Guidelines effective January 17, 2024.

Effective January 17, 2024, the new Federal Poverty Guidelines (FPG) have been implemented and will be used to determine eligibility for Emergency Assistance (EA). The EA income standard for initial eligibility is 115 % of the FPG, the continuing eligibility standard for remaining in EA is 200% of FPG. This change has been programmed into ASIST. Below is the chart to use when determining eligibility.
