Donations are written in on Line 33f of the Massachusetts Income Tax Form.

The donations go into the Homeless Animal Prevention and Care Trust (Mass Animal Fund)

Mass Animal Fund utilizes the funds to help community animals through free animal control officer training, and free spay/neuter/vaccinations.

Free spay/neuter/vaccinations vouchers are issued to eligible animals.

-cats/dogs owned by low-income MA residents

- trap/neuter/return cats.

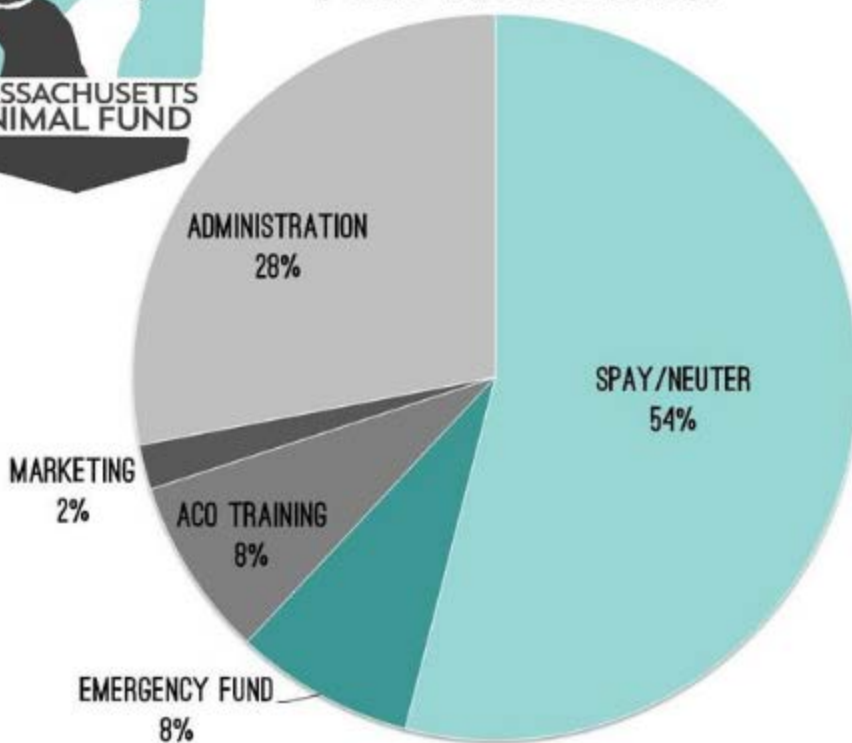
-cats/dogs at risk in emergency situations:
