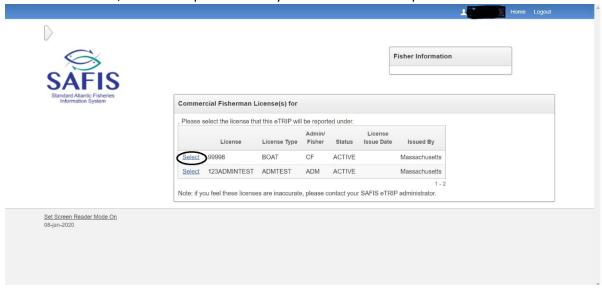
## **How to use SAFIS to View Reports of Previous Trips**

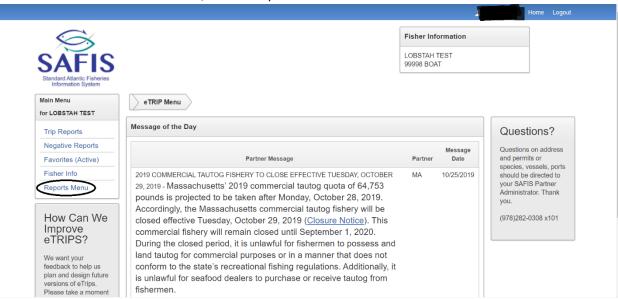
1. Log-in to SAFIS and select "SAFIS Electronic Trip Reports (eTrips)- Fisherman".



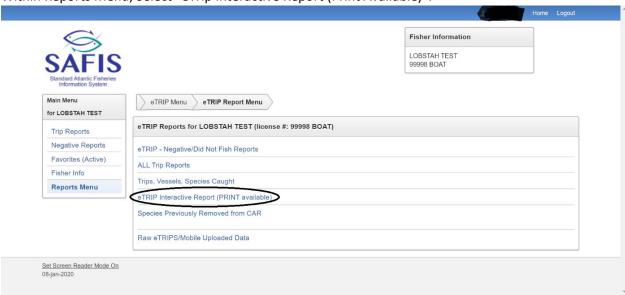
2. On the next screen, choose the permit which you wish to create a report on.



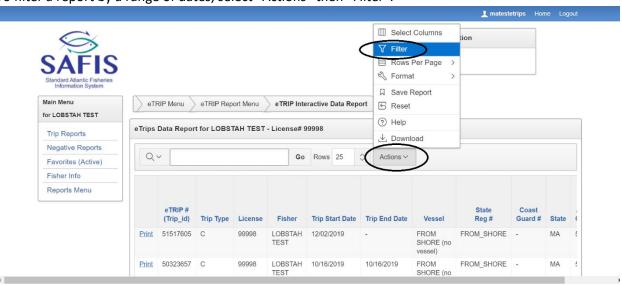
3. On the left-hand side of the screen, select "Reports Menu".



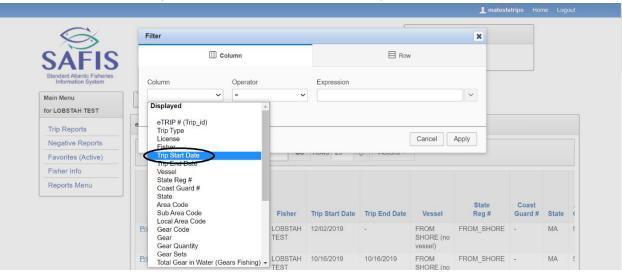
4. Within Reports Menu, Select "eTrip Interactive Report (Print Available)".



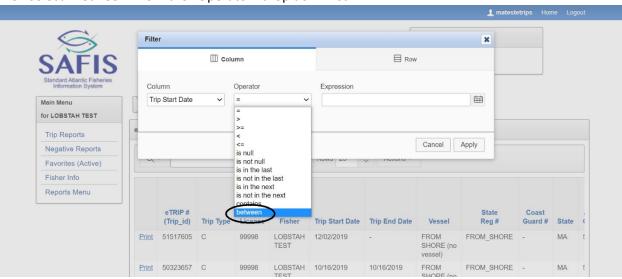
5. To filter a report by a range of dates, select "Actions" then "Filter".



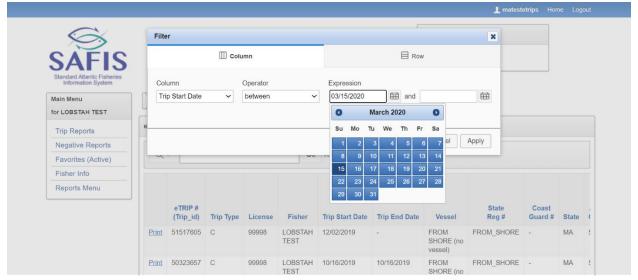
6. Within the filter, select "Trip Start Date" from the "Column" drop down list.



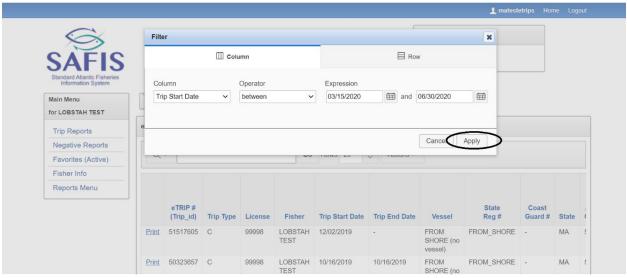
7. Then select "Between" from the "Operator" drop down list.



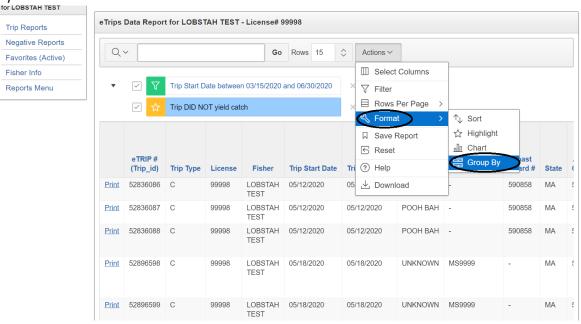
8. Under expression use the calendar or manual entry (MM/DD/YYYY format) to fill in the boxes under "Expression". These are the range of dates you wish to view trips from.



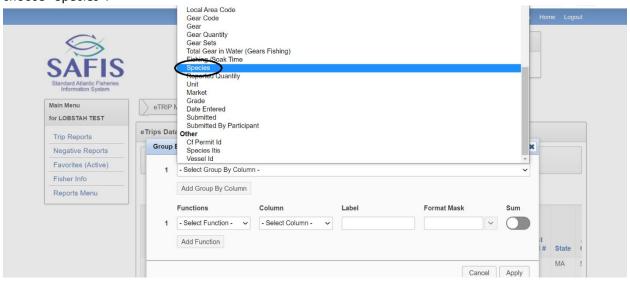
9. Below is an example of filters used to select trips from 03/15/2020 through 06/30/2020. When you have completed your filter fields, select "Apply".



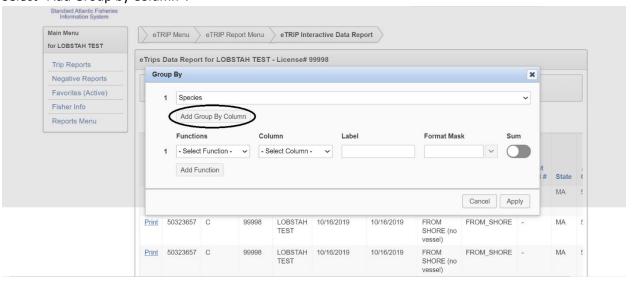
10. To summarize the weights of catch from this time period, select "Actions" then "Format" then "Group By".



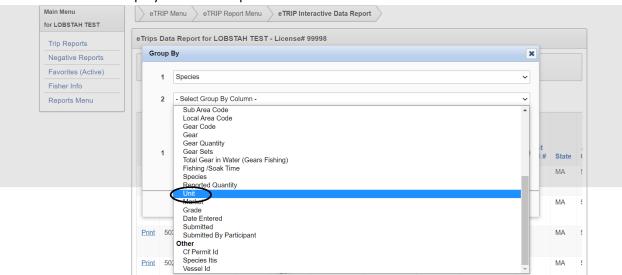
11. This interface can be used to summarize how much of an individual species you landed and the unit (count, lbs, etc.) that the catch was landed in. Click the "Select Group by Column" list then choose "Species".



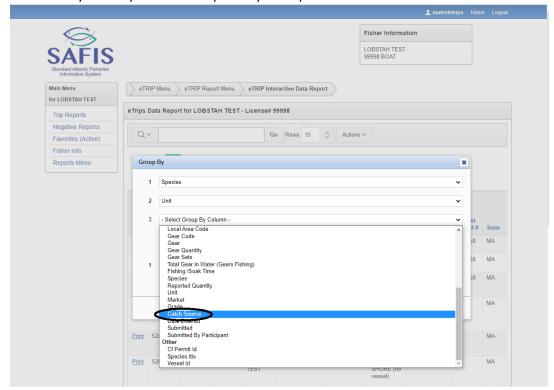
12. Select "Add Group by Column".



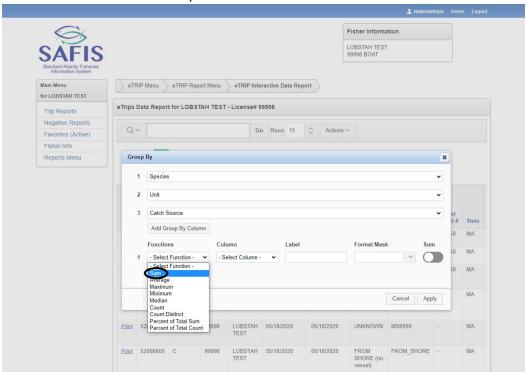
13. Now click "Select Group By Column" drop down and choose "Unit".



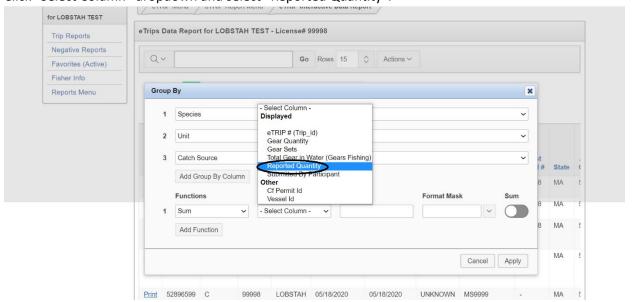
14. To view data grouped by "Catch Source" (aquaculture, standard), select "Add Group by Column" then click "Select Group by Column" dropdown list and choose "Catch Source". This is unnecessary unless you wish to separate your Aquaculture and Standard catch.



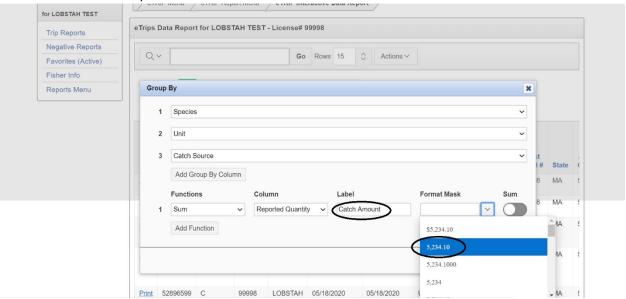
15. Click the "Select Functions" dropdown and Select "Sum".



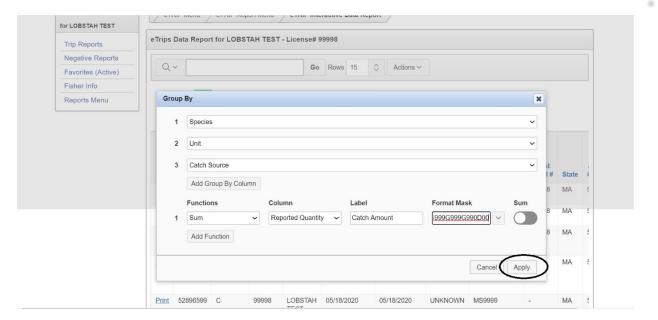
16. Click "Select Column" dropdown and select "Reported Quantity".



17. Enter a custom name in the box under label. In this example, I used "Catch Amount". Use the drop down under format mask to choose the format of your "Catch Amount", I chose to round data to the hundredths place.



18. The group by interface will appear as below, ignore the code in the "Format Mask" box and click "Apply".



19. The result is a summary table for catch between 03/15/2020 and 06/30/2020. See example below.
