**DECISION**

**HANY TADROUS D/B/A HUBBARDSTON MARKET**  
**32 MAIN STREET**

Hany Tadrous d/b/a Hubbardston Market (“Licensee”) holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (“ABCC” or “Commission”) held a hearing on Tuesday, September 23, 2025, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigators Gould and Fleming’s Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On Thursday, May 29, 2025, at approximately 4:47 p.m., Investigators Gould and Fleming (“Investigators”), conducted a compliance check at Hany Tadrous d/b/a Hubbardston Market.
2. An underage operative, working under the supervision of Investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, one 25 ounce can of Bud Light beer, for four dollars and fifty-nine cents (\$4.59). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2010 with one prior violation.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Therefore, the Commission **SUSPENDS the license for a period of one (1) day which will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations are found by this Commission.**
