	Our kitchen is safe. Children have to stay at least 3 feet away from the stove.
	The stove area is free from clutter.
	Pot handles always face in when cooking.
	When grown-ups cook, they keep a pot lid nearby to put out stovetop fires.
	No items that can burn are near our stove.
	We stay in the kitchen when cooking.
He	eating Safety
	We keep space heaters at least 3 feet away from drapes, curtains and
	other things that can burn.
	Our wood stove is clean and 3 feet away from furniture and other things that can burn.

 The furnace is cleaned and serviced once a year before the heating season begins. Our fireplace has a screen in front of it. When we go to bed, we make sure the fire is out. 	
Electrical Safety	
 □ We charge phones and other electronics on hard surfaces. We never charge on a bed, under a pillow or on a couch. □ The electrical outlets in our home are not overloaded. □ Each outlet has only one cord plugged into it. □ Heaters and air conditioners are plugged directly into a wall outlet. □ Power strips have no more than two things plugged into them. □ Electrical cords are not under rugs or doors. 	
Candles, Matches and Lighters	
 □ The adults in our home keep matches or lighters away from all children. □ When we leave a room, we blow out all candles. □ We keep a 1-foot circle of safety around candles. 	
More Household Fire Safety:	
 □ All flammable liquids are stored in air tight containers outside and away from the house. □ We clean lint from the dryer after each use. □ The area around our furnace or heater is free from clutter and anything that can burn. □ We store gasoline outside and away from the home.
