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





Complete future I-495 NB in Median, Fruit Street, and Ramps ES

#### Stage 2

June 2024– May 2026

Complete future I-495 SB, Ramps WS, WN, and SE

#### Stage 3/3b

April 2025– April 2027

Complete Ramp NE, NW, SW & EN

#### Stage 4


August 2026– June 2027

Complete I-90 widening, remove former loop ramps and complete environmental mitigation areas



# Key Project Elements & Proposed Modifications

- Project limits extend approximately
   3/4 mile in each direction
- Complete replacement of the Interchange
- Elimination of old toll booth area and weaving areas
- Extremely sensitive environmental resource area





### **I-90**

- 3 lanes in each direction with minor widening
- Minimal changes to roadway profile and cross slope
- Bridge over MBTA/CSX/Amtrak to be replaced
- Fiber optic cables in median and EB shoulder to be relocated
- Culvert at Whitehall Brook to be replaced





### **I-495**

- 3 lanes in each direction
- Additional (4th) lane will be provided to Route 9
- Future I-495 NB will be constructed within the existing median
- Future I-495 SB will be in its existing location
- Bridges over MBTA/CSX/Amtrak and I-90 to be replaced
- I-495 NB bridge over Flanders Road to be replaced





# Complete Interchange Reconstruction— Including 8 New Ramps






#### **Fruit Street**

- Will be completed in 2 major stages
- 2-way, 1-lane alternating traffic (under signal control) during major stages

#### Flanders Road

- Replacement of I-495 NB bridge superstructure over Flanders Road
- Constructed with an overbuild to maintain 3-lanes of travel
- Utility work on Flanders Road below I-495








# **Environmental Considerations**

- Interchange is located near sensitive natural resources
  - Cedar Swamp ACEC
  - Sudbury River
  - Whitehall Brook
  - Surrounding wetlands and floodplains
- Permits
  - Issued during preliminary design
  - Require continued agency involvement as designs advance
  - Require construction and post-construction oversight






## **Traffic & Staging Considerations**

#### I-90 & I-495

- Maintain 3 lanes on mainlines, except for short-term closures during approved off-peak hours
- Maintain all ramp connections between I-90 and I-495, including along temporary alignments
- Maintain proper signage and markings
- Provide temporary roadway lighting along ramps
- Provision of safe construction access/egress

#### **Local Roadways**

- Maintain resident and local business access/egress
- Fruit Street—maintain 1-lane; 2-way alternating traffic with signal during bridge replacement
- Flanders Road—short-term lane closures to support bridge & utility work











# 2024 Traffic Milestones

- I-495 SB traffic shifted to existing median (future I-495 NB)
- I-495 NB traffic remains as today
- Associated I-495 SB on/off-ramp modifications
- Scheduled Implementation
   Summer 2024 (post Memorial Day)





- Northern crossover limits
- I-495 SB traffic shifted to existing median (future I-495 NB)—north of MBTA/RR





- I-495 SB traffic shifted to existing median (future I-495 NB)
- Temporary Ramp Connections—
   I-495 SB to I-90 EB & WB (SE/SW)










- Southern limits of crossover
- I-495 SB traffic shifted back to existing alignment under Fruit St.
- Temporary Ramp Connections—I-90
   EB & WB (ES/WS) to I-495 SB









Proposed ramp provided between I-90 EB and I-495 SB

#### **INITIAL CONDITION**

- New direct I-90 EB connection to I-495 SB (ES) opens
- I-90 EB to I-495 NB continues to use temporary I-90 EB off-ramp (EN)








#### **INITIAL CONDITION**

- New direct I-90 EB connection to I-495 SB (ES)
- Joins with temporary Ramp WS to merge with I-495 SB









#### **FINAL CONDITION**

- Part of a 2-lane off-ramp from I-90 EB (splits to Ramp ES and Ramp EN)
- Combines with future Ramp WS to provide 2-lane on-ramp to I-495 SB






#### **Fruit Street**

- Replacement of Fruit Street bridge over I-495
- Involves additional roadway, utility and landscaping features
- 2-way, 1-lane alternating traffic (under signal control) during major stages

#### **UPCOMING-Summer 2024**


- Traffic to be shifted to newly constructed section of bridge
- Remaining existing bridge to be demolished/final construction





## I-90 over Whitehall Brook

- Bridge carrying I-90 over Whitehall Brook to be reconstructed in multiple stages
- Requires traffic shifts along I-90 EB and WB
- Requires modifications to I-90 WB on-ramp and I-90 EB off-ramp






# I-90 over Whitehall Brook Stage 0/1

- Stage 0 involves I-90 roadway grading, median reconstruction and drainage work
- Stage 1 requires traffic shifts along
   I-90 EB (to the north)—crossing
   constructed to the south
- Stage 0/1 anticipated to commence—
   Spring/Summer 2024



#### Noise Program: Hot Line 508-676-3551

- The Noise Control Plan (NCP) established baseline sound levels (Fall 2022).
- Quarterly noise monitoring will be conducted to ensure construction noise remains in compliance.
- Noise control mitigation measures to be used by the contractor include:
  - Temporary noise barriers or noise curtains
  - Limit use of loud and impact equipment to the daytime as feasible
  - Use of local power grid to reduce generator use
  - Use of self-adjusting backup alarms
  - Use of approved truck haul routes (I-90, I-495 and Route 9)





# Ramp ES

- New direct ramp provided between
   I-90 EB and I-495 SB
- Part of a 2-lane off-ramp from I-90 EB (splits to Ramp ES and Ramp EN)
- Combines with Ramp WS to provide
   2-lane on-ramp to I-495 SB



\*Ramp Designations indicate directionality—i.e., **Ramp WN** connects I-90W to I-495N



# Ramp SE

- New loop ramp from I-495 SB to I-90 EB
- Part of a 2-lane off-ramp (splits to Ramp SE and Ramp SW)
- Enter I-90 EB as a single lane on-ramp





# Ramp WN

- New direct ramp provided between
   I-90 WB and I-495 NB
- Single lane ramp
- Entrance to I-495 NB begins additional 4th lane NB to Route 9





# Ramp WS

- New semi-direct ramp provided between I-90 WB and I-495 SB
- Single lane off-ramp
- Combines with new Ramp ES to provide 2-lane on-ramp to I-495 SB





# Ramp EN

- New semi-direct ramp provided between I-90 EB and I-495 NB
- Part of a 2-lane off-ramp (splits to Ramp EN and Ramp ES)
- Enters I-495 NB as a single lane on-ramp on the I-495 NB bridge over I-90





# Ramp NW

- New semi-direct ramp provided between I-495 NB and I-90 WB
- Single lane off-ramp
- Combines with Ramp SW to provide a 2-lane on-ramp to I-90 WB





# Ramp NE

- New direct ramp from I-495 NB to I-90 EB
- Single lane ramp
- Enters I-90 EB as a single lane on-ramp on the I-90 EB over the MBTA/CSX/Amtrak bridge





# Ramp SW

- New semi-direct ramp from I-495 SB to I-90 WB
- Part of a 2-lane off-ramp (splits to Ramp SW and Ramp SE)
- Combines with Ramp NW to provide a 2-lane on-ramp to I-90 WB





#### **Fruit Street**

- Replacement of Fruit Street bridge over I-495
- Will be completed in 2 major stages
- 2-way, 1-lane alternating traffic (under signal control) during major stages
- Emergency vehicle pre-emption to be provided at signal
- Involves additional roadway, utility and landscaping features





#### Flanders Road

- Replacement of I-495 NB bridge superstructure over Flanders Road
- Constructed with an overbuild to maintain 3-lanes of travel
- Utility work on Flanders Road below I-495
