Overnight Lane Reductions on I-90

Lane reductions on Friday, May 2, and Saturday May 3, from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. the following morning

NEWTON/WESTON – The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is announcing lane reductions on I-90 eastbound and westbound between the I-90/I-95(Route 128) Interchange and the Commonwealth Avenue Overpass in Newton and Weston. Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction during overnight hours on Friday, May 2, and Saturday, May 3, from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. the following morning. These reductions are required to conduct necessary preparation activities for upcoming weekend work as part of the Newton-Weston bridge replacement/rehabilitation at I-90/I-95 (Route 128) project.

During the lane reductions, all vehicles will be directed to the eastbound roadway. There will be no impacts to the Commuter Rail during the lane reductions.

Drivers traveling through the affected areas should expect delays, reduce speed, and use caution.

Appropriate signage, law enforcement details, and advanced message boards will be in place to guide drivers through the work area.

All scheduled work is weather dependent and subject to change without notice.
