The Board of Registration in Pharmacy (Board) is in receipt of your Massachusetts Pharmacy Technician Registration No. 9193 (exp. 08/18/10) which you returned to the Board (received March 29, 2010) in accordance with the *Temporary Order of Suspension* issued by the Board on March 25, 2010 regarding above-referenced Complaint No. PHA-2010-0039 (Complaint).

Please be advised that the Board has accepted the surrender of your pharmacy technician registration in resolution of the Complaint on the terms and condition that you understand and agree your surrender is voluntarily tendered; that registration surrender is considered to be a disciplinary action depriving you of all privileges of registration; that registration surrender is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review; and that the Board will not review any application for licensure as a pharmacy technician in the future.
