Impounded Case

Where all care and protection proceedings are statutorily impounded; where Rule 11 of the Uniform Rules of Impoundment Procedure provides that any party or interested nonparty may file a motion for relief from impoundment; and where the Juvenile Court allows such a motion for access to audio recordings but with certain conditions, including limitations on when and what portions of the recordings can be further disseminated, whether the conditions constitute a prior restraint of speech that violates the First Amendment to the United States Constitution and art. 16 of the Massachusetts Declaration of Rights.
