

FACT SHEET

Theme: Infants and Toddlers¹

Care: courses that address multiple aspects of caring for infants and toddlers, including development, health and safety, learning environments, and family involvement; 2) <u>Growth and Development</u>: courses that specifically focus on the physical and emotional growth and development process from birth to three years; 3) <u>Curriculum</u>: courses that specifically focus on creating a developmentally appropriate curriculum for infants and toddlers; and 4) <u>Development and Curriculum</u>: courses that incorporate the study of infant and toddler development into the design of an appropriate curriculum.
