## Everyone has a role in accessibility

ADA Title II requirements for digital content and services have been announced and state and local governments must be in compliance by April 24, 2026. **All state employees**, regardless of role, must do their part to ensure the Commonwealth provides a secure, inclusive, accessible, and welcoming digital environment for all.

PROGRAM MANAGERS PRODUCT MANAGERS PROJECT MANAGERS	<ul> <li>Complete all required and provided trainings</li> <li>Make digital accessibility a core requirement for projects and programs</li> <li>Provide tools, training, and time to allow team members to make digital accessibility part of their day-to-day work and skill development</li> <li>Track vendor accessibility commitments in contracts</li> </ul>
UX/UI AND DEVELOPMENT TEAMS	<ul> <li>Complete all required and provided trainings</li> <li>Conduct accessibility testing for pages and applications during design and development and during the QA process</li> <li>Conduct accessibility testing and fix issues before publishing</li> <li>Conduct and seek out accessibility peer reviews</li> </ul>
CONTENT CREATORS	<ul> <li>Complete all required and provided trainings</li> <li>Conduct accessibility testing and fix issues before integration</li> <li>Ensure multimedia content has captions, a transcript, and audio descriptions</li> <li>Conduct and seek out accessibility peer reviews</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Complete all required and provided trainings</li> <li>Explain the state's accessibility requirements to agency</li> </ul>

## PROCUREMENT AND CONTRACTING TEAMS

- Explain the state's accessibility requirements to agency purchasers
- Include the required accessibility contract language in all new bid requests and amended or renewed contracts that include software or electronic deliverables
- Obtain an Accessibility Conformance Report (ACR), such as a VPAT<sup>®</sup> from the vendor for any software in their proposal
- For any items in the ACR that are "partially met" or "not met," include a mitigation plan for the vendor in the contract with timelines for resolution of those items



HUMAN RESOURCES	<ul> <li>Complete all required and provided trainings</li> <li>Ensure all staff complete training requirements</li> <li>Ensure all job postings are accessible</li> <li>Conduct accessibility testing of HR processes, projects, and onboarding</li> <li>Include digital accessibility as a skill under qualifications for job postings</li> </ul>
COMMUNICATIONS TEAMS	<ul> <li>Complete all required and provided trainings</li> <li>Conduct accessibility testing on all emails and Word, PowerPoint, Excel and PDF files before they're distributed</li> <li>Conduct accessibility testing on social media posts and fix issues before posting</li> <li>Conduct and seek out accessibility peer reviews</li> </ul>
LEGAL, RISK, AND COMPLIANCE TEAMS	<ul> <li>Complete all required and provided trainings</li> <li>Stay aware of statutory and regulatory changes related to nondiscrimination on the basis of disability and accessibility, including applicable case law</li> <li>Communicate and provide guidance about legal IT accessibility requirements to leadership, managers, and staff</li> <li>Support dispute resolutions, including notice to vendors who are under contract and fail to resolve accessibility issues</li> <li>Include IT accessibility requirements in compliance protocols</li> </ul>
OTHER EMPLOYEES	<ul> <li>Complete all required and provided trainings</li> <li>Make digital accessibility part of your day-to-day work</li> <li>Ask questions and seek out resources to help your colleagues and others</li> <li>Conduct and seek out accessibility peer reviews</li> </ul>
